

HONORS & HIGH HONORS DISTINCTIONS

Awarded at the end of Semester I and Semester II.

- Academic Honors: Students who earn a weighted GPA of 3.7 (A-) or above and have no grade lower than a B- for their courses will receive the distinction of Academic Honors.
- Academic High Honors: Students who earn a weighted GPA of 3.7 (A-) or above and have no grade lower than an A- for their courses will receive the distinction of Academic High Honors.

SIGNATURE PROGRAM & GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- MEDscience Honors: MEDscience combines hands-on clinical cases and classroom lessons. Students travel to Harvard Medical School weekly and participate in ER-simulated case studies. Entry to the program is competitive for Class 12 students.
- Public Speaking: Students learn to speak and write effectively by preparing and delivering an annual public address to fellow students, faculty, and administrators.
- Community Service: All students must complete at least 40 hours of community service prior to graduation.
- Senior Independent Learning Experience: In May, seniors explore passions or new areas of interest through real-world experiences. Students are required to complete 120 hours of supervised activity, reflect about their experience, and present to a panel of peers and faculty to showcase their culmination of work.
